

Public Works Departments:

- A contractor has been authorized to paint the parking stalls downtown. We are waiting to be placed are their schedule
- Dura-Patching has resumed. Please call in Potholes to the Street Dept. at 937-845-3058. Speaker System installation is complete.

Water Department:

- Sanitary Survey: Updating the number of private well locations to complete our backflow program.
- Adam's Street Tower demo is 90% completed. The City still needs to remove the foundations and waterline. This has been delayed due to valving issues in the old section of town and other prioritized work.
- We have submitted a water infrastructure grant in the amount of \$2.5 million to replace lead service lines, water main, and mainline water valves that are 85 years old, in the old section of

Sewer Department:

- Currently awaiting engineering agreement to start the Secondary Clarifiers' 1&2 with American Rescue Plan Funds and minimal local Wastewater funds. Estimated \$295,000 ARP Federal and \$10,000 local.
- Applied for an OPWC grant to pay 50% of the cost of the Primary #2 Clarifier with matching funds from American Rescue Plan. OPWC Funds \$98,500 & 98,500 ARP Federal Funds.
- WWTP Superintendent and I met with an engineering firm to discuss future major plant upgrades. This plan will be a phased approach for replacement and upgrades of the WWTP.

2021 Road Reconstruction/Resurfacing Projects:

- Fenwick Phase I has been awarded to Sturm Construction in the amount of \$290,000. Reconstruction started on 10/13. Grant was approved in the amount of \$372,000 with the City's matching share estimated to be \$59,000.
- Clark County Resurface Project: Resurfacing is complete. The City's is awaiting the final cost to Overlay Sunset, Cambridge Ct., Deerfield and S. Scott (Between Madison and Linden).

Madison St. School Demo:

The demolition of Madison School is complete. Total Project cost = \$171,496. CDBG share = \$169,360. City's share = \$2,136.

Lowrey asks about the striping on the streets. Grimm asks about Falcon Dr.. Kitko notes it is on the radar with Villa and Henry. Kitko notes some things may need reconfigured on Villa and Henry and will need more repair. Brubaker and Mill- will be pothole repair. Eggleston asked about the streets sweeping. Kitko noted he has been in contact, sent more photos and they did come back and redo some spots. Lowrey asks about phase 2, Kitko notes he did apply for grant funds for 2023. Lowrey thanks Kitko.



ORDINANCE 2021-40

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 1246 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF NEW CARLISLE REGARDING CITY POLICY

WHEREAS, Chapter 1246 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of New Carlisle addresses the City's Board of Zoning Appeals; and

WHEREAS, the City of New Carlisle is having difficulties with finding citizens to volunteer for various City boards, including the Board of Zoning Appeals; and

WHEREAS, not having quorums on these boards presents operational challenges for the City, its residents and its business owners; and

WHEREAS, due to the issues described above, an amendment to the Codified Ordinances is necessary.

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF NEW CARLISLE HEREBY ORDAINS that Chapter 1246 of the Codified Ordinances of the City of New Carlisle be amended with the addition of the italicized language below:

1246.06 UNFILLED VACANCIES

Notwithstanding anything contained in the Codified Ordinances to the contrary, Council shall serve as the acting Board of Appeals anytime there are fewer than three (3) members appointed to and serving on the Board of Appeals. During such times as Council is serving as the acting Board of Appeals, the following provisions shall apply:

- (a) Council shall assume all duties, rights and responsibilities of the Board of Appeals.
- (b) An affirmative vote of a quorum of Council is necessary to reverse any order, requirement, decision or determination of the Inspector; to decide in favor of the applicant on any matter upon which it is required to pass under this Zoning Code; or to effect any variation in the application of this Zoning Code.
- (c) At any Board of Appeals meeting, the Mayor or, in his or her absence, the Vice Mayor shall act as Chairman of the Board. If both the Mayor and Vice Mayor are absent from a meeting, Council shall select a temporary Chairman of the Board by a majority vote of the members present. The Chairman of the Board may administer oaths and compel the attendance of witnesses at Board of Appeals meetings.
- (d) Board of Appeals meetings shall only be held during Council's regular or special meetings.

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING THE EXPENDITURE OF FUNDS OF OVER TWENTY THOUSAND DOLLARS (\$20,000) AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY MANAGER TO PURCHASE A SECONDARY CLARIFIER FOR THE WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT, AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY

WHEREAS, the City's wastewater department currently maintains two 40-year-old secondary clarifiers; and

WHEREAS, one of the 40-year-old secondary clarifiers has stopped working and cannot be rebuilt in a cost-effective manner or reasonable time without custom work because manufacturer parts are no longer available – in essence, the clarifier has reached its end of life; and

WHEREAS, the City is currently using only one operational secondary clarifier; and

WHEREAS, this has put the City in an emergency situation because it is only a matter of time before the remaining 40-year-old secondary clarifier reaches its end of life and there currently is no back-up to maintain proper operations; and

WHEREAS, the City is working closely with the Ohio EPA to best navigate this situation and the Ohio EPA recommends that the City expedite the procurement of another secondary clarifier; and

NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY OF NEW CARLISLE HEREBY ORDAINS as follows:

- <u>Section 1.</u> The City currently faces an emergency in which it must immediately procure and replace equipment, namely its defunct secondary clarifier, to preserve the City's wastewater treatment operations for the City's sewer system.
- Section 2. Steel Adjustment Formula

Due to the volatile nature of carbon and stainless steel, CSE reserves the right to adjust our price based on NYSE American Steel Index is the price index used to determine steel prices. As the steel index fluctuates, the price follows. Since we are quoting in the current year for clarifiers that will be built in years to come, the following formula tied to the NYSE Steel Index will be used to calculate adjustments at the time each clarifier will be started.

For example, the Index Reference Point is set at the 1Q 2021 average value of 861.72 as of 4/1/2021.

The portion of the sell price affected by the steel index is 45%.

Therefore, the applicable purchase price of each clarifier will be adjusted by the following formula:

(NYSE American Steel Index at START DATE – Index Reference Point)/(Index Reference Point)*0.45

Example 1:

If the NYSE American Steel Index at the start date of a unit quoted in 1Q 2021 is 750, then the variance is

(750-861.72)/861.72=12.9%.

Applying the 45% material cost to the above percentage results in a discount of 5.83% against the purchase price in this quote.

Example 2:

If the NYSE American Steel index at the start date of a unit quoted in 3Q 2020 is 1000, then the variance is

(1000-861.72)/861.72=16.0%.

Applying the 45% material cost to the above percentage results in a surcharge of 7.22% against the purchase price in this quote.
