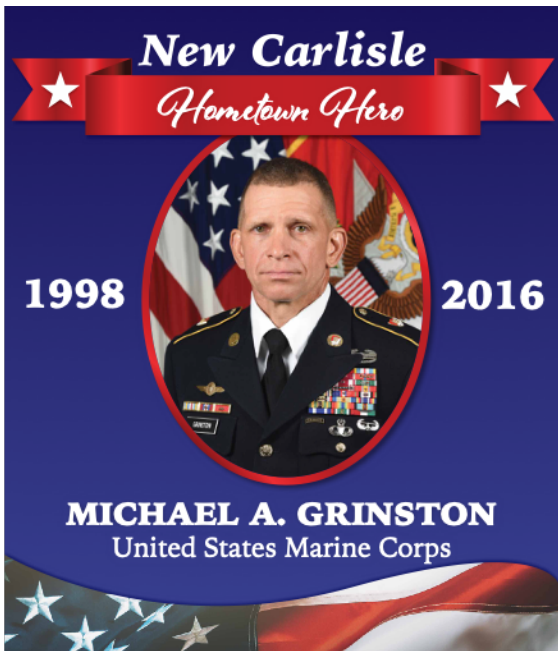

City Council approved legislation directing the City Manager to re-establish the mayor's court that once operated in our city. A mayor's court operates similar to municipal and county courts. The fines and fees generated by the mayor's court will help fund the city's general fund and police fund. The mayor's court runs every other Wednesday at the Sheriff's Sub-station downtown located at 101 S. Main Street. Court starts at 6:00 pm.

City to Build Additional Shelter House

Available to Rent with a Kitchenette

The city has partnered with the Clark County Economic Development Department to secure \$430,000 in CDBG-CV grant funds to design and build a new shelter house in Smith Park. Accessible by West Washington Street, the new shelter will offer wifi, a modern design, bathrooms, and a kitchenette. The new shelter house is much needed as the demand for the current shelter house remains high. The project is expected to be completed by Summer 2023!

City Assesses Certain Properties

Annual Ordinances in August

Every August, City Council acts on legislation that assess property taxes for grass cutting and nuisance abatements, utility account liens, and street lighting. Not all residents are assessed for street lighting due to those areas of town not having street lights. Residents are able to pay their street light assessment at the City Building before they are sent to the auditor’s office in mid-September. Notifications of these assessments, and when to pay at the City Building, are placed in the Springfield News Sun, the city’s Facebook page, and at www.newcarlisleohio.gov.
